#### **Room Parent Responsibilities:**

- Set up initial meeting with classroom teacher(s). o Ask about how best you can help.
- Discuss generic email (provided) and correct based on info.
- o Determine the best way to stay in touch (e.g., email, notes in a folder).
- Assist teacher(s) (as they request) in communicating with families.
- o Send out a monthly newsletter with reminders about upcoming events:
  - Curriculum shares
  - Early-release days and holidays
  - PTO events and outings (check PTO calendar and Z notes and receive

monthly email update from Brandy)

- o Circulate teacher wish lists and suggest donations.
- Coordinate holiday and year-end gifts for teachers and classroom aides.
- o In the Fall, collect classroom dues via venmo and/or check sent directly to the room

parent collecting the classroom dues for teacher and aide gifts. The suggested amount is \$20/student.

- Communicate to parents that Class Dues are different from PTO Dues.
  - Class Dues are collected by Classroom Room Parents and are used to fund holiday and end of year gifts for your classroom teacher and classroom aides. Class Dues do not go towards funding PTO efforts.
  - PTO Dues go towards annual PTO programming and initiatives such as Creative Arts & Sciences programming, teacher stipends, and community events. We ask that each Zervas family pay PTO dues annually via Membership Toolkit and suggest a donation of \$30 per family.
- Emphasize desire for 100% participation but that dues are voluntary and parents should give what they are comfortable with. (Some families will be able to give a larger amount, other families will only be able to give a smaller amount, \$20 is average.)
- One room parent keeps collected funds until needed.

o The PTO provides a budget of \$250 per grade. Please send reimbursement forms

and receipts to the PTO Treasurer's email (Shruti Bansal, bansalshruti1@gmail.com). Keep all supporting documents and receipts in a folder to give to the treasurer when we are able to meet in person. Plan for 120 staff members. Coordinate the date(s) for your events through Brandy
